
CONTRIBUTOR PROFILES



MIKE DWORETSKY

Mike was an astronomer at University College, London and was also Director of the University of London Observatory. He grew up in California and was awarded his doctorate at UCLA, followed by two years of researching at Mount Wilson and Palomar Observatories before moving to England. He has been a student of the case since first attending a lecture by Mark Lane at UCLA in 1966. His first research was a photographic investigation, conducted with other students, to determine whether or not the shadows in the famous backyard photographs could be genuine. His interest was rekindled by reading Anthony Summer's Conspiracy in 1980 and discovering discrepancies in the acoustic evidence as presented to the HSCA. This led him into correspondence with the late Harold Weisberg. He is especially interested in the forensic aspects of the case. A

founder member of DPUK in 1996, Mike has written articles for The Echo and has been a presenter at Canterbury in past years. His prowess as our auctioneer is now well established.



BARRY KEANE

Barry has been a very active member of Dealey Plaza UK for many years and is currently vice-chairman of the Group. He was 13 at the time of the assassination and has been studying all aspects of the case closely ever since he first saw the Zapruder Film in 1978. He has visited Dallas on two occasions and gave a joint presentation with former Bethesda Naval Hospital medical illustrator Harold (Skip) Rydberg at the 2003 Lancer Conference. Barry is particularly interested in the overall picture and the reasons why JFK was murdered.



Ed grew up on an Homestead, went to school at a university in Oregon, lives in Hawaii and nainland United States. He was very interested in Jack Ruby's motive to kill Lee Oswald, at a very young age. He did not believe it even at the tender age of 7. Having questioned his parents about what they knew I decided the story was a cover, or a lie. He had the pleasure of early internet" and read many early theories on bulletin boards and chat rooms of the 80's. Then he read "Best Evidence". Lifton had a theory that was interesting so Ed decided to examine every bage and search for all the answers for himself.

Whilst agreeing that the body was the best evidence, the theory that it could have been tampered with ultimately destroyed that theory in of itself.

Ed focused his attention on Oswald as that was the focus of the authorities and Warren Commission. If he was not firing a rifle out a window then he must have been somewhere else. If he was not shooting a pistol at a police officer then he had to be elsewhere. neighbours and posting his interviews at JFK Lancer.

A much different picture emerged of the Oswald family by speaking to those who lived around Marina and Lee. While at ROKC a highlight was working on Prayer Man research and Stan Dane's book of the same nomenclature. Outstanding research evidence by the group points to Oswald, and confirms Sean Murphy. Ed began the search for first day news accounts, and the original Weigman and Darnell footage. The films have been located but access has been denied by the powers that be. Ed has written some humour filled essays and posts on the so called evidence:

ALARIC ROSMAN

Alaric was born in Rottingdean, Sussex in December 1934. He has been a lot of things in a quirky life: a National Serviceman (in the Air Force); a commission-only salesman; a London University (external) B.SC graduate, a state and private secondary school teacher, and, finally, a museum warder at the National Gallery, London, where he was the senior trade union representative. He vividly remembers the Assassination, and listened through most of the night to the news reports. Even at that very early stage, he felt that what he was hearing didn't ring quite true, a conviction that has grown stronger and sharper over now nearly 50 years.

Alaric joined DPUK in 2002, and since then has contributed nearly 35 articles to the Journal; this will be the eleventh Seminar at which he has contributed a presentation. Alaric was also one of the authors who contributed

to the DPUK book published in 2013, "JFK: Echoes from Elm Street". Alaric is determined to uncover everything there is to know about that

Alaric will be talking to us this weekend about his research into Oswald's association with the CIA using material from the Warren Commission documents.



LARRY HANCOCK

Larry is a graduate of the University of New Mexico with a BA in Education and majors in Anthropology, Sociology and Education. Following service in the United States Air Force, he worked in the telecommunications and computer communications fields for some 35 years - with Continental Telecom., Hayes Microcomputer and Zoom Technologies. During his career he held the positions of Technical Trainer, Technical and Engineering Training Manager, Marketing Manager and Marketing Director. He became involved with Kennedy assassination research in the early 1990's, and has focused on intelligence and national security aspects of the conspiracy. He has published a variety of document collections and analysis on CD with JFK Lancer, contributed articles and essays to Lancer, DPUK, and the Mary Ferrell Foundation. His first book, with Connie Kritzberg (former Dallas reporter) was "November Patriots", a "docufiction" piece on

the Kennedy Assassination. His second book, "Someone Would Have Talked", a factual study of the Kennedy conspiracy and cover-up is now in its third (2010) edition.

Larry has also done research on the RFK assassination, publishing a lengthy series of essays, Incomplete Justice, on the Mary Ferrell website and with Stuart Wexler spent some five years researching the assassination of Martin Luther King Jr.; the two wrote a book which documents a four year effort to kill Dr. King, entitled "Awful Grace of God". The book was published in 2012. He has also published a book entitled "Nexus: The CIA and Political Assassination (2011) and his latest e entitled "Shadow Warfare: The History of America's Undeclared Wars", was published in 2014 He was also one of the authors who contributed to the DPUK book published in 2013, "JFK: Echoes from Elm Street".



VINCE PALAMARA

Vince Palamara is considered the leading civilian Secret Service authority, having interviewed and corresponded with over 80 former agents, many from the JFK era. Vince is also the author of three books: Survivor's Guilt (2013), JFK: From Parkland to Bethesda (2015), and The Not-So-Secret Service (2017). Vince is married and resides in Pittsburgh, PA (USA).

Vince has appeared on the History Channel, local cable access television, YouTube, radio, newspapers, print journals, at national conferences, and all over the internet.

A former JFK Secret Service agent Joe Paolella once proclaimed to Vince: "You seem to know a lot about the Secret Service, maybe even more than I do"

The title of Vince's talk today is "The Secret Service Failure on 22nd November 1963 – Why President Kennedy should have survived Dallas.



RUSSELL KENT

Russell runs a management consultancy company in Essex. He has a degree in physiology and spent two years in post-graduate research at St Thomas's Hospital in London. Whilst most aspects of the JFK assassination medical evidence interest him, he is particularly concerned with the single-bullet theory and the wounding of John Connally. Russell has published several papers on the case and appeared on Black Ops Radio. He has given presentations in Canterbury, Cambridge, Stockholm and Dallas where, in 1998, he was on the JFK Lancer Medical Panel with David Lifton and Dr David Mantik." He has undertaken much research into the case, particularly on the autopsy evidence.



JASON WILCOX

Jason first became interested in the Kennedy Assassination in 2006, shortly after reading alternative accounts of the 9/11 terror events. At about the same time, he read the article in the "Times" magazine about DPUK, and promptly joined the group. He worked for a number of years at a literary agency, and subsequently has written and directed film dramas, several of which have been screened at small-scale festivals in the UK

Jason, until quite recently, lived in one of the flats in the converted Board School on Durward Street which would have been a dominant landmark in 1888. The area was then known as Bucks Row and is famous as being the spot where the first official victim of Jack the Ripper, Mary "Polly" Nichols, was found murdered in the early hours of 31st August 1888. Our "sister" group is "TheWhitechapel Society" and many here today, would know the area well!

RANDOLPH BENSON

Randolph is the Director, Co-Producer, and Editor of the film "The Searchers" that is being screened at this seminar. The film has garnered numerous awards, most notably an Academy Award for Best Student Documentary at the Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences'Academy Awards. Randolph also received an Eastman Kodak Excellence in Filmmaking Award at the Cannes Film Festival and a First Appearance Award at the International Documentary Film Festival Amsterdam. He has been an instructor of film and video at the Centre for Documentary Studies at Duke University for over a decade, and he serves on award juries at the Full Frame Documentary Film Festival (Durham, NC, USA) and the "Let's All Be Free" Film Festival in London.



STEPHEN GOETSCH

Stephen is the Director and Executive Producer of the film "A Coup in Camelot" which is being screened at this seminar. He has been involved with the film and television industry for over twenty years. From his roots in Wisconsin, starting as an Assistant Editor, he has since become an accomplished editor of film and television, editing hundreds of hours of national television on all major networks, including MTV, A&E, Discovery, Food Network, and National Geographic. He is also an award-winning screen writer.

Assassination, knowing that Russell was very interested in Nurse Diana Bowron. Russell has converted these interviews to MP3 and it is fascinating to hear the witnesses original voices and the way Harry did his research. With only the exceptions of Drs. Humes, Boswell, and Finck, no-one in the world got a better look at the back of President Kennedy's head, and his wounds, than nurse, Diana Bowron (who originally came from England) at Parkland hospital. She actually washed the President's hair after his death, and assisted in cutting

away his clothing when he was first brought in to Trauma Room One.


The Secret Service failure on 22/11/63 – Why JFK should have survived Dallas

10.30am – 11.30am Tabernacling in the Bowels of the Warren Commission Alaric Rosman

> The gist of Alaric's talk will be that by lowering himself into the very bowels of the Commission (it's thousands of exhibits and documents), he can establish from the Commission material (and using no other material) that it was well known to the Commissioners that Oswald worked for American intelligence, that the Commission material clearly shows that Oswald was framed and that there



were at least two people using his identity. This was obvious 40 years before John Armstrong wrote his book "Harvey and Lee". Very likely there were three "Oswalds". The "Oswald" who "returned" from the Soviet Union was a Russian intelligence agent --- and known to be such by the CIA). The key point is that Alaric

does not use any information not published in the Warren material --- that is he uses no information obtained after November '64 --- which means that all his conclusions were obvious 53 years ago.

In addition, Alaric will provide a handout. This will contain the actual presentation, with a continuation of it's arguments, plus a line of reasoning that the Oswald of the Warren Commission was very likely a CIA creation, rather in the same way that Sherlock Holmes was a creation of Conan Doyle. Well, not quite! But nearly true. Again, in support of his arguments, Alaric never strays from what is in the November 1964 Warren material.

11.30am - 12.40pm Predictive Programming in the Assassination of President Kennedy: Is This an Example?" Film/Talk Jason Wilcox

Predictive programming is a recurring element across many conspiracy theories. The claim is that when conspirators plan a false flag operation, they hide references to it in the popular media before the atrocity takes place; when the event occurs, the public has softened up, and therefore passively accepts it rather than offering resistance or opposition. Jason will come up with some surprises here!

During Sunday lunchtime our President, Mr Ian Griggs, will be demonstrating the operation of the so called "Mannlicher-Carcano" rifle that he owns. It is a version of the famous Italian rifle that is very similar to the one supposedly purchased by Lee Harvey Oswald and supposedly used to assassinate John Kennedy.
